2. General

2.1. This event will count for :

3. Description of circuit

Place :	Môlča – Banská Bystrica - Autocross Area
Length :	980 m
Width of the start :	18 m
Maximum width:	20 m
Minimum width :	12 m
Location:	On the Road from Banská Bystrica, direction to Brezno turning to the right on the Village Šalková , Môlča

- 5.2 Participants from abroad must have their consent ASN in accordance with Article 70 of the International Sporting Code

6. Entry fees

- 6.1 Normal fee : 100,- €, Increased fee: 150,- €
Normal fee for D4 Euraca Cup 2010: 40,- €, Increased fee: 60,- €.
Hobby autocross: 35 E
All the fees will be selected during the administrative checking.
The additional fee for competitor who refuses to carry the organiser 's sponsor 's advertising: 120,- €.
7. Insurance
The event is written in the SAMŠ calendar and it is insured against the driver 's responsibility toward third parties.

IV. CHECKING

9. Administrative checking
 - 9.1 All drivers must report to administrative checking which will be held at Administrative building – Secretary office on 29th May 2010 (Saturday) from 08h00 to 11h30. Drivers must submit all valid documents for year 2010.
10. Scrutineering
 - 10.1 Every car taking part at the event must be presented by the rider or his official representative to scrutineering which will be held on 29th May 2010 from 08h15 to 11h45
 - 10.2 No cars will be allowed to start unless it complies with the current FIA safety regulations (Appendix J).

V. RUNNING OF THE EVENT

12. There are going to be 2 official timed practices in following conditions: 6 cars, 5 laps from the enter of the first driver to the track.
Each driver must complete at least one lap in practice.
14. Qualifying
The are 3 Heats of Qualifying:
There will be: 5 laps, D4 : 4 laps.
Only those drivers having totalised less than 21 points in two Heats will be admitted to the Finals.
15. Finals
Finals will be: 7 laps, D4: 5 laps.

VI. PARC FERME - RESULTS – PROTESTS

18. Parc Fermé
Only those cars having taken part in the Finals must be brought by the drivers to the Parc Fermé immediately after the last race for which the driver qualified. The cars shall remain in the Parc Fermé for at least 30 minutes after the publication of the provisional results. In this area, it is forbidden to make any repair to the vehicle or to carry out refuelling.
19. Results
The results will be posted a.s.a.p. on the official board after each Heat and Final.
20. Protest - appeals
All the protests will be lodged in accordance with the International Sporting. Code.
All the protests must be made in writing and handed to the clerk of the course or his assistant, or in their absence to any of the stewards of the meeting, together with the financial sun.

VII. PRIZES AND CUPS

21. Prizes
 - 21.1 The prize giving ceremony will be organised after the Finals. Each driver of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places

- must be present on the Prize giving Ceremony dressed in racing dress
- 21.2 Financial prizes
Financial prizes will not be payed, drivers will be awarded prizes.
- 21.3 Prizes and cups
The Awards Ceremony will be organised after the Finals.

VIII. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

22. Fire Extinguishers
Each driver is responsible for ensuring that a single piece extinguisher of minimum 5 kg is available within his own team area inside the paddock.
23. Protection of the Environment
Each drivers is requested to ensure that a plastic sheet (minimum 4 metres by 5) is spread on the ground in the place reserved for his team where work is to be done on his car, in order to prevent any pollution in case of an accidental leak, et.
24. Driver Liaison Officer Mr. Zuzana Kocúrová, will be reached in driver's paddock close to entrance to the track during all the championship. The Drivers' Liaison Officer will be recognisable by yellow vest and his picture will be posted on the Official Notice Board .
